Call for abstracts:

In the last decades, countless books, articles, and reports have speculated, or even diagnosed, deep crises of democracies throughout the world. Although it could be argued that the Covid-19 pandemic has fuelled a crisis of government, rather than a crisis of democracy, in most places, it has doubtlessly increased political polarisation and exacerbated inequalities across and within societies.

How democracies die, and what roles digital practices and technologies play in this process, stands in the centre of this one-day multidisciplinary conference. We welcome contributions that shed light on these questions in empirical and conceptual ways. We would be particularly excited about empirical studies showing the dynamics by which democratic values and processes are hollowed out in ways that involve digital tools and practices beyond the “hot topics” of fake news and misinformation.
